## Congratulations

The Longden Grip you have chosen is constructed of the finest materials. This product requires particular care, so please read the following instructions.

The Longden Grip is a patented, new and innovative stability aid for riders of all ages and skill levels who are seeking additional security as they develop their balance, seat and riding skills. It is also ideal for those wanting extra security when riding a young horse, bringing a horse back into work, or riding a horse they are not quite sure of.

#### Instructions for Use

The Longden Grip is a stability aid which is designed to provide riders with an easily reachable solid handhold should they become unbalanced or unstable in the saddle.

Simply grasp the padded bar section with either or both hands and brace yourself, taking care to maintain contact with the reins at all times. Release the bar when you have regained your balance or repositioned yourself to a more stable position.

## Warnings

The Longden Grip is designed for use as a stability aid only and is NOT intended to be a safety device.

Do not tie, attach or fasten any item or article to the Longden Grip for any reason

Do not use the Longden Grip as a handhold for mounting or dismounting the horse.


Only fit the Longden Grip as shown. Failure to do so may result in discomfort to the horse, or excessive movement of the grip.

## Fitting Instructions

Whilst it is possible to fit the Longden Grip to a saddle already on a horse, for ease of fitment we recommend fitting the Longden Grip prior to saddling the horse.


Step 1.

Lift the saddle flaps, to expose the girth straps.




Step 2.

If the saddle is fitted to the horse, release the girth straps slightly.




Step 3.

Slide the Longden Grip in and under the girth straps.



Step 4.

Wrap the velcro strap around the girth straps to locate the Longden Grip. If the saddle is already fitted to the horse, re-tighten the girth straps.



Step 5.

Reposition the saddle flaps.



**Note:** To remove product reverse the above steps.

## Care/Cleaning

Your Longden Grip is designed to provide years of maintenance free service, however, we recommend regular cleaning for hygiene and care of the product. After use, clean the Longden Grip with a mild soap and water solution.

Do not use alcohol or petroleum based cleaners, solvents, or harsh abrasives. We do not recommend the use of plastic protectant products as these can make the surface of the grip slippery.
